

INFLAMMATION AND INFLAMMATORY DISEASES Master 2 program

Registration procedure

The Inflammation and Inflammatory Diseases (IID) Master 2 program is open to European students who successfully completed their Bachelor Degree (3 years post-college) or their Master (4 years post-college) and who already possess a strong background on the biology and mechanisms and molecular aspects of inflammation and immunology.

Application / selection schedule:

- Before may 15th: Inquire and apply
- Between may 15th and June 1st: Interview of candidates
- By June 15th: Confirmation of the selected candidates
- June 15th to July 1st: registration at the University

Final Registration will be only possible after students obtain the agreement of a partner laboratory to host them during their training.

Training will preferentially take place in Inflamex partner' laboratories.
